TOWN OF LANARK

PARKING ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 6-20

Section 1: Title/Purpose

This ordinance is entitled the Town of Lanark Parking Ordinance. The purpose of this ordinance is to prevent parked vehicles from impeding safe passage of agricultural and emergency equipment on town roads.

Section 2: Authority

The Town Board of the Town of Lanark has the specific authority, powers and duties pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Sec. <u>346-51 - 346.56</u> and by the Town of Lanark's general authority pursuant to its adoption of Village powers pursuant to Sec. 60.10 Wis. Stats.

Section 3: Adoption of Ordinance

The Town Board of the Town of Lanark has, by adoption of this ordinance, confirmed the specific authority, powers and duties noted in this ordinance and has established by this ordinance the means to regulate and control roadside parking in Town of Lanark to accomplish the purpose set forth above.

Section 4. Parking Restrictions in specific places

It is unlawful for the operator of a vehicle to park such vehicle in any of the following places when appropriate signs giving notice of such NO PARKING have been erected and are in place in locations listed below

A. Within 400' on either side of the Tomorrow River Bridge on the south side of Otto Road, as posted.

Section 5. Penalties

Any person who violates Section 4 of this ordinance shall forfeit not less than \$30 nor more than \$300 per authority and limits provided by Wisconsin Statute 346.56(2). Each day or partial day of continued violation shall constitute a separate offense. In addition, without limiting the authority of the Town to impose the forfeiture, the Town may cause a vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance to be towed.

Section 6: Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
