PROCEEDINGS OF THE MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETING TUESDAY, DECEMBER 13, 2022

The Lanark Town Board met at the Town Hall on Tuesday, December 13, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. Chairperson Mike Pagel, Supervisors Bill McKee and Elmer Garms, Treasurer Theresa Maves, Clerk Cheryl Leatherman, employee Bob Dahms and two residents were present.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairperson M. Pagel. All stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Notices were posted at the Town Hall and on the town website.

- 1. The minutes from the Town Board Meeting of November 15, 2022 were reviewed. Motion by E. Garms seconded by B. McKee and carried 3-0-0 to approve the minutes as written.
- 2. Public input: None
- 3. The building permit applications summary was reviewed., There were no zoning permits and no surveys to be reviewed.
- 4. No county violations and no local violation were discussed.
- 5. The Board discussed calling a hearing for Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use Map amendment of parcels 022-22-1014-03.04 and 022-22-1014-02 to apply Natural Areas Protected and rezoning these parcels to apply Conservancy zoning to the revised floodplain according to a Letter of Map Revision dated September 7, 2022. Motion by B. McKee seconded by E. Garms to hold a public hearing on these changes and carried 3-0-0. The meeting is scheduled for prior to the next town board meeting.
- 6. M. Pagel provided information on the Tomorrow River School District tax increase.
- 7. The Board discussed the reassessment for 2023. No action was taken.
- 8. John Droske gave a GCAC report.
- 9. The Board discussed the snowmobile route ordinance. No action was taken as no one has come forward to request one.
- 10. B. Dahms gave a report on the tree taken down on Park View.
- 11. B. Dahms gave a report on equipment issues experienced so far this winter.
- 12. The November 2022 treasurer's report was reviewed. There was \$42,857.52 in checking and \$369,073.58 in Money Market. The treasurer's report was reviewed and approved by unanimous consent.
- 13. The 2022 Budget Overview was reviewed and approved by unanimous consent.

- 14. Changes to the 2022 Budget Overview were reviewed. Motion by E. Garms seconded by B. McKee and carried 3-0-0 to approve the changes as presented by the clerk.
- 15. The Check Listing by Bank Account-11/16/2022-12/13/2022 was reviewed and approved by unanimous consent.
- 16. The Balance Sheet for November 2022 was reviewed and approved by unanimous consent.
